**ACREAGE CROP REPORTING
STREAMLINING INITIATIVE**

“ACRSI”

ACRSI is pilot program designed to streamline acreage reporting with your crop insurance agent and the FSA office. With ACRSI you can report acreage (insurable and non-insurable) with your insurance agent. The data is then shared electronically with the FSA office. Once acres have been reported to your insurance agent, you will need to visit your FSA county office where they should be able to pull your data from ACRSI. You then verify for accuracy, fill in any additional required information, and sign your FSA certification.

KEY POINTS TO REMEMBER:

ACRSI does NOT change any Crop Insurance reporting requirements or deadlines.

ACRSI does NOT change any FSA reporting requirements or deadlines.

The grower is still required to complete an acreage report with their insurance agent.

The grower is still required to certify their acreage with their FSA office.

You do NOT need to sign up for ACRSI.
